REVD HILARY WRITES...

On 30 July I was licensed by the new Bishop of Lynn, Bishop Jane, at St Mary's Tittleshall, as Assistant Priest for Launditch and the Upper Nar, my thanks to everyone who joined us and for the warm welcome you gave me. Since then I have taken services in Tittleshall, East and West Lexham, Weasenham St Peter and Rougham, where the welcome has been just as friendly. I look forward to meeting more of you in the months ahead.

I have lived in Norfolk for almost 30 years and in Tittleshall for the last 14, but since my ordination eight years ago I have served as a non-stipendiary priest in the Swaffham and Sporle benefice. With the retirement of both the Revd Heather Butcher and the Revd Julia Hemp, and with my husband due to retire in September, it seemed a good time to offer my services locally for two days a week.

For eight years before I began my training for the priesthood, I was the Chief Executive of the Royal College of General Practitioners, having spent all my career working in education, with various different professions and organisations including teachers, local education authorities, lawyers, podiatrists and doctors. In addition to my work for the Church, I wanted to continue my involvement with healthcare, so I became a non-executive director of the Norfolk and Waveney Primary Care Trust and subsequently Chair of the Audit Committee and Deputy Chair of West Norfolk Primary Care Trust.

I was a Trustee of the Royal Society of Medicine for six years until September 2020, and in my final two years I also served as their Vice-President.

Until the pandemic struck, my husband and I split our week between Norfolk and London, spending too much of our time on the M11. Since then we have felt very blessed to have been in Norfolk full time, enjoying village life and the beautiful countryside that surrounds us. While many of us have been so fortunate, we hold in our prayers all those who have experienced sickness or bereavement during the past 18 months, and trust that the year ahead will bring an increasing return to normality.
